



2005 PARADUXX Napa Valley Red Wine

In The Vineyards – 2005

- The growing season was initiated with above average rainfall
- An ideal fruit set produced abundant clusters and exceptional fruit
- A lengthy harvest concluded in early November

Sensory Profile

- The aroma explodes with ripe fruit—strawberry, boysenberry, and plum, complemented by hints of violets, spice, and orange peel.
- This wine is medium-bodied with a chewy texture, robust yet approachable tannins, and a firm, lengthy finish.
- Ripe flavors of raspberry, red cherry, and boysenberry are balanced by complex notes of dark chocolate, espresso bean, and black licorice.
