

## 2013 THE DISCUSSION NAPA VALLEY RED WINE



"2013 was a great year to be a cabernet grape in California,' said Josh Thomas of SF's Octavia when he tasted this wine, a blend of 61 percent cabernet sauvignon, 25 percent merlot, the balance cabernet franc and petit verdot. It brings a Right Bank style to

Napa Valley, with merlot making the tannins approachable, providing impressive oak integration and richness (after 18 months in barrel, 95 percent new, it spent another six months in neutral oak). The flavors are dark and juicy, completely savory in their supple, fruity-dark-chocolate richness."
